The MMEHR course Human Resources multicultural recognition and evaluation 4.0

The MMEHR open online course Human Resources multicultural recognition and evaluation 4.0 is available in English, Italian, Greek, Romanian, German and Turkish. Created by the University of Naples Federico II, University of Thessaly and Stefan cel Mare University of Suceava, the contents of the course include texts, references for further study and media, which have been edited, branded and and finalised in the online platform by Janus, as partner providing technical services and visual identity coherence. The 8 modules of the course are created to:

- Create awareness among students and trainers on the possibility of acquiring ICT skills in order to teach

recognition/ management/ evaluation;
- Create a multidisciplinary, real-life problem-based educational curriculum for trainers and students, involving the sector of Human Resources recognition/management;

and study multicultural 4.0 techniques related to HR

- Share educational content related to HR professionals (Train the Trainers courses) using OERs
- Contribute to the reforms related to the 2011 EU Modernisation Agenda enhancing lifelong learning via the creation of flexible learning paths

The MMEHR course supports students and HR managers to acquire a specific top-quality expertise on the multicultural and multidimensional aspects of the labour market. The MMEHR course contributes to the empowerment of the learners' European citizenship, providing tools to better understand and interpret the current multicultural and multidimensional world. Prior to accessing the course, free registration on the learning platform FEDERICA is required. The course is open access, made available as OER.
